Linkage & Navigation Services

Linkage-to-Care

- to identify newly diagnosed HIV-positive persons and link them to primary care services
- to identify HIV-positive persons who have discontinued care and re-link them to primary care services

Linkage & Navigation Services

Navigation Services

- Individualized support to assist clients in identifying and accessing health and support services (i.e. family planning services, medical case management, SSI, housing assistance, legal services, therapeutic services)

-Client schedules first appointment with applicable cohort and/or accesses available services the same day



Scenario A

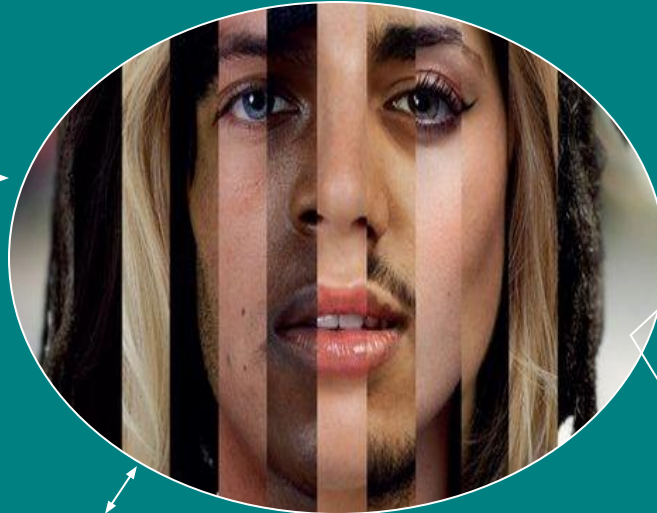
Mike

I'm homeless at the moment, and I've been selling my meds for money since I usually lose them otherwise. Either, I get high and forget where I leave stuff or it gets stolen. If I had somewhere decent to stay, I'd probably get back on meds.

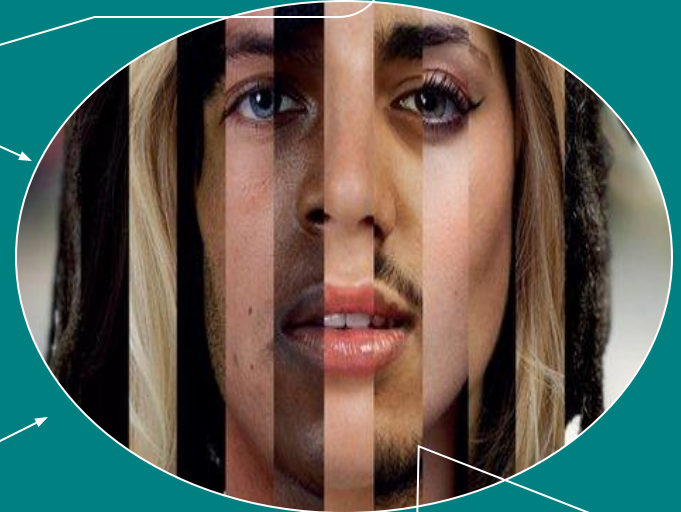


I'm cool on the substance use program for now, maybe later. I could really use the help with housing, though. Thank you.

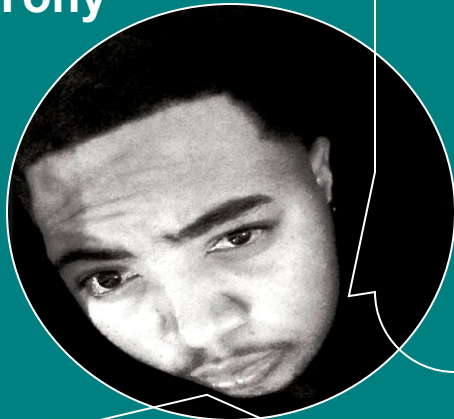

Scenario C

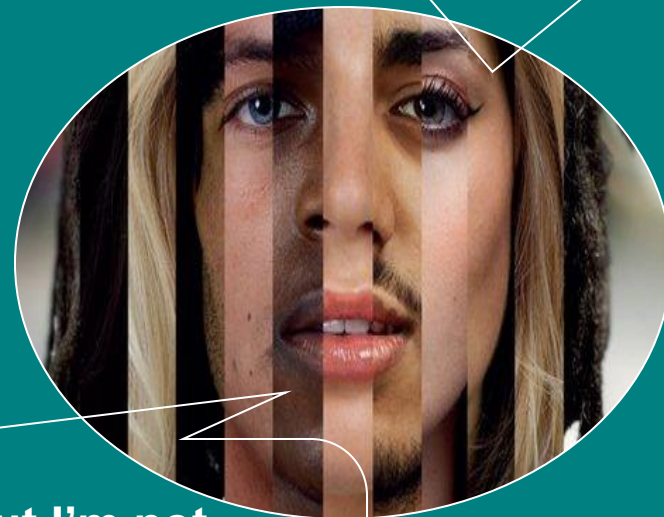
Tony



Tony, receiving an HIV positive result can be overwhelming. If you want a few moments alone, I can wait just outside this office, or I can sit with you, if you'd prefer.

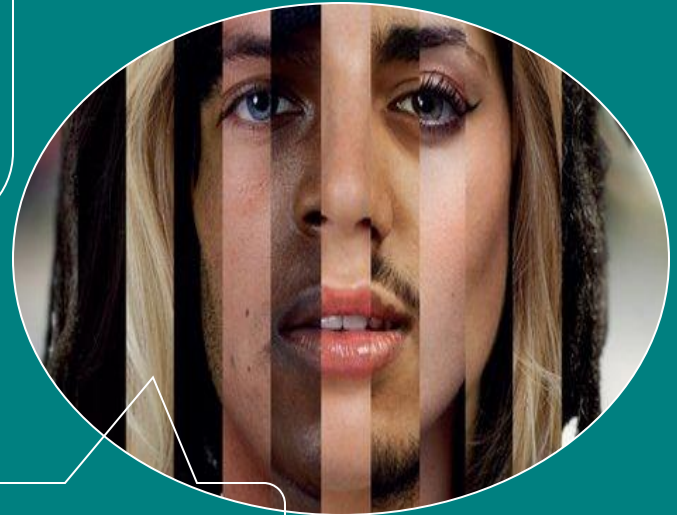
We have case managers that can assist you with next steps. We also have a clinic that can provide HIV medical care.

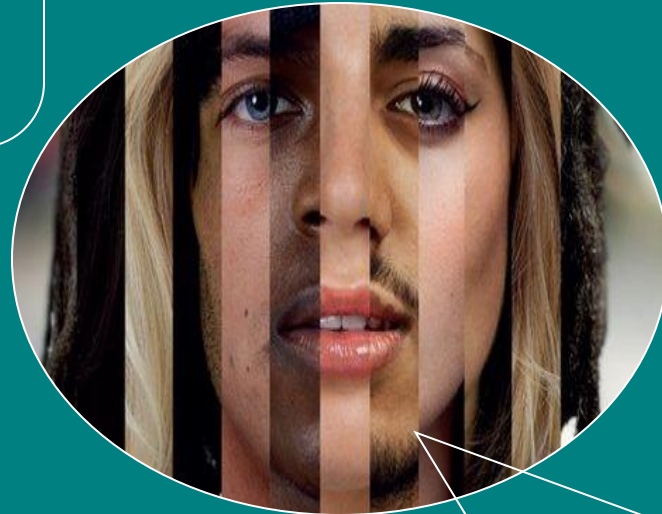


That I can do. Thanks.

...3 ARTAS SESSIONS LATER

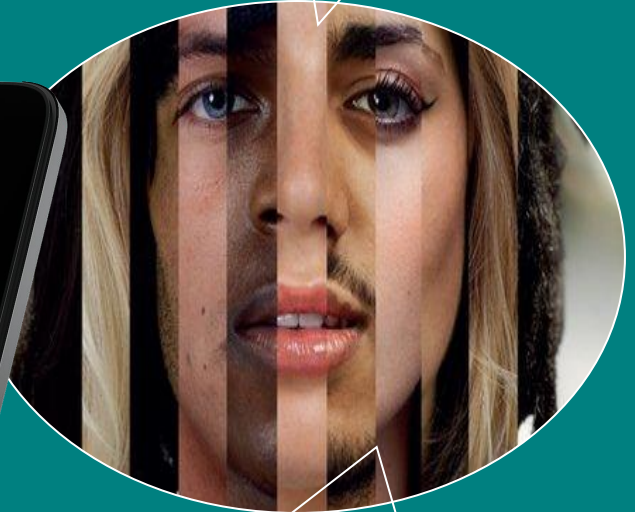
Thanks for making it in today, Tony. When I called to confirm our appointment yesterday, you said you hadn't been feeling well. How are things going?
